One of the things that sets LifeChoices apart is our desire to build genuine relationships with our clients. We don't always get the opportunity to connect with a client multiple times, but when we do, the impact can be incredible.

Earlier this year, Andrea* came into our clinic for a pregnancy test. She was homeless and her boyfriend said it wasn't a good time for them to have a baby. He wanted her to have an abortion, even offering to pay for it. Andrea was honest to say she felt conflicted about the decision and thought an abortion would be emotionally challenging. Over the next two weeks, three different staff members met with Andrea to provide various services. One staff member treated her for two sexually transmitted infections. Another nurse provided ultrasounds to confirm her pregnancy was developing as it should. And yet another team member met with her to discuss resources that were available throughout our community to assist her with making a parenting plan. By the end of those two weeks, Andrea had tools to move forward with carrying her pregnancy but was still unsure of her decision. She repeatedly said, "I really want to keep this baby, but there is so much going on in my life that it makes it hard to consider."

Two months later, Andrea reached out to us and admitted that she had not yet seen a doctor for her pregnancy due to a lack of transportation, nor had she decided whether or not to carry her pregnancy. She shared she felt "stuck" and her boyfriend was still pushing for an abortion. She came to the clinic once more and our team continued to offer her encouragement, support, and resources. Before she left that day, we assisted her with getting an appointment with a local physician so she could move forward with the healthiest pregnancy possible.

Several weeks later, one of our nurses was asked by a county jail to assist a pregnant woman in their custody. When the nurse arrived, it was Andrea who sat before her. She told the nurse she had been arrested for trespassing while looking for somewhere to sleep at night. She had no idea how long she would be in jail but her main concern was continued exposure to infections that could affect her and her baby. She anxiously shared that she hadn't felt the baby move recently — she was deeply concerned about the life growing within her. In that moment, our nurse was able to provide an ultrasound, address her infection concerns, pray with her, and make a follow-up care plan.

Like so many of our clients, Andrea's journey is still ongoing and undoubtedly complex. However, regardless of what comes next, she knows that **LifeChoices is here for her.** Because of your partnership with LifeChoices, our team will be able to continue sharing God's love, grace, and kindness with Andrea and her baby.

BEAUTY FROM ASHES

Elisabeth Elliot wrote "Of one thing I am perfectly sure, God's story never ends with ashes."

Her husband was one of five missionaries killed while in service to the expansion of God's Kingdom and yet she chose to return with her daughter to the very tribe who killed him with a desire to continue sharing the redeeming love of Jesus. She chose to overcome the ashes of sorrow with the hope of eternal life.

For many who are caught in sexual exploitation and human trafficking there often seems no way out and no one who cares. Beauty has been turned to ashes and life has been beaten into sorrow.

But God, in His redeeming love, has given LifeChoices unique access to many of these individuals through years of providing advocacy and medical services during victim-centered law enforcement operations to recover missing and/or exploited individuals. The stories we hear are harsh and at times our help is rejected, but the beauty of God's hope often endures beyond that initial crisis intervention. Our team continues to faithfully invest in these women and pour unrelenting love over their deep wounds of emotional and physical pain for many months (or even years) after we meet them.

One of the young women we connected with through these efforts jotted a note on a bright pink post-it and left it with our clinic receptionist a few weeks ago. She wrote:

"Hey! I haven't seen you in a while. I wanted to tell you I got into a nursing program! I couldn't have made it this far without your help and I'm so so blessed to have met such a light in my darkest time. Thank you for all you do for the young women in our community. Love you longtime. You are a hero!"

As the facilitating organization of the RISE Coalition (Regional Intervention of Sexual Exploitation) LifeChoices stewards these opportunities with a deep sense of honor and responsibility. It's because of you and your investment in the mission of LifeChoices that any of this is possible. Since 2016, we have served over 335 survivors of exploitation and partnered with law enforcement on more than 30 victim-centered operations.

Following a recent operation, one of the detectives sent this note, "I very much appreciate your team's help with this...Each of these girls were so sad in their own way and have suffered a lifetime of abuse and neglect. They deserve to know people, even strangers, care about them. Hopefully with a little nudge they will discover a path to a new and better life. Again, thank you."
